Page 24 Rule 4 – Players & Substitutions

Courtesy Runner: Exception should read – If the player that made the last out is on base, on deck or due up to bat, the player who made the previous out prior to the last out will be used. (If the player that is on base is a courtesy runner and is due up to bat, that player's spot in the batting order is skipped and the next batter becomes the legal batter – refer to Rule 7 – Batting, section 3)

Fast Pitch Section

Adult Men's Fast Pitch Rules

Page 140 Rule 2 – The Playing Field

The base distance will be 60ft. (not 660ft)

Eight & Under Coach Pitch

Page 146 Rule 5 – The Game

Exception: In the last inning, the maximum of 11 batters per half inning will be waived and the offensive team can bat any number of batters until the defense records three outs. This exception only applies to the playing of the last official full inning.

Rule 4 – PLAYERS/SUBSTITUTION

Sec. 2 The Designated Hitter (DH) and the Extra Player (EP):

4. Should read: The (DH) may be substituted for at any time, either by the player being hit for, a pinch hitter, or a pinch runner. If the substitute is the player being hit for, he/she must bat in the same order as the (DH), and the use of the (DH) will be terminated for the remainder of the game.

Everything else in 4 is eliminated from this section.

5. Everything in this section is also eliminated.
