Paul Armstrong joined the NSA family in 1990 as the first SP UIC for the state of Alabama and has solely retained that role through today. During his time with NSA, Paul has been the UIC for every Slow Pitch (Adult and Youth) Word Series held in the state of Alabama. He has also been the UIC for every Senior, Church and Co-Ed World Series tournaments held in either the state of Alabama or the Panhandle of Florida. Paul has also UIC'd countless local, state and regional tournaments and has been a driving force for the NSA's growth in the state of Alabama.

Paul has been awarded several state and national awards while with NSA. He received the Alabama State UIC of the Year award in both 1997 and 1999, became a Lifetime Hall of Fame Member in 1998 and was awarded the Mike Coppinger UIC of the Year Award in 2004 at the NSA National Convention.

Throughout his career in NSA, Paul has traveled hundreds of thousands of miles conducting countless clinics, teaching and mentoring thousands of umpires and supporting and promoting the NSA. He consistently registers hundreds of umpires every year and continues to grow his umpire core through his loyalty and never wavering resolve to make NSA the best that it can be.
